**ON THE CASE ON CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT ON AIR COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA SIGNED ON APRIL 4, 2011 IN BELGRADE WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of the Case consideration and being ruled by Article 100 (2), Parts 1 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations, stipulated by the Agreement on Air Communication between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Republic of Serbia signed on April 4, 2011 in Belgrade, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
