ON THE CASE ON CONFORMITY OF ARTICLE 14, PART 3, POINT 4 OF THE LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA "ON THE JUDICIAL SERVICE" WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON THE BASIS OF THE APPLICATION OF THE CITIZEN ARMEN KHARATYAN

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and being ruled by provisions of Article 100, Part 1 and Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 19, 63, 64 and 69 of the RA Law on "The Constitutional Court", the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. Article 14, Part 3, Point 4 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on Judicial Service, taking into account the legal positions stated in this Decision, and considering that the legal regulation pursues a legitimate aim for promotion of independence of the judge and effectiveness of his/her activities, is in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
