**THE CASE CONCERNING OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT
ON SCIENTIFIC TECHNICAL COOPERATION SIGNED BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND REPUBLIC OF
TURKMENISTAN IN YEREVAN ON NOVEMBER 29, 2012 WITH THE CONSTITUTION
OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the Case and being ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 1 and 4, Article 102, of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on Scientific Technical Cooperation signed between the Governments of the RA and Republic of Turkmenistan in Yerevan on November 29, 2012 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
