DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A PILOT PROJECT TO PLACE CONTROL (IDENTIFICATION) TAGS ON GOODS CLASSIFIED AS "ITEMS OF CLOTHING, CLOTHING ACCESSORIES AND OTHER ITEMS MADE OF NATURAL FUR" IN 2015-2016 SIGNED ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2015 IN GRODNO WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63,64 and 72 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on the implementation of a Pilot Project to place control (Identification) tags on goods classified as “Item of Clothing, Clothing Accessories and other Items made of Natural Fur” in 2015-2016 signed on September 8, 2015 in Grodno are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
