DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON TRAINING PERSONNEL FOR THE ORGANS OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS (THE POLICE) AND INTERNAL TROOPS OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES SIGNED IN YALTA, ON MAY 25 2007 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Based on the results of consideration of the case and in accordance with Point 2, Articles 100, Points 1 and 4, Article 102 of the RA Constitution, Articles 63, 64, and 72 of the RA Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations of stipulated in the Agreement on Training Personnel for the Organs of Internal Affairs /the Police/ and Internal Troops of the Member States of the Commonwealth of Independent States, signed on 25 May 2007 in Yalta are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of announcement.
