

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL ON AMENDMENTS TO THE BASIC MULTILATERAL AGREEMENT ON INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE EUROPE – THE CAUCASUS – ASIA CORRIDOR IN RESPECT OF THE NEW STATUS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BULGARIA AND ROMANIA ACCEDED TO THE EU ON 1 JANUARY 2007 SIGNED ON 13 DECEMBER 2007 IN ASTANA WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Considering the results of the examination of the case and guided by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on "The Constitutional Court," the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Protocol on the Amendments to the Basic Multilateral Agreement on International Transport for Development of the Europe - the Caucasus - Asia Corridor in Respect of the New Status of the Republic of Bulgaria and Romania acceded to the EU on 1 January 2007 signed on 13 December 2007 in Astana are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
