DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON REGULATION OF THE FINANCIAL MATTERS WITH THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION (NATO) CONCERNING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE MILITARY UNITS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA IN THE INTERNATIONAL SECURITY FORCE IN AFGHANISTAN SIGNED ON 19 OCTOBER 2009 AND 20 OCTOBER 2009 IN THE FORM OF EXCHANGE OF LETTERS WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the results of consideration of the case and in accordance with Point 2, Article 100, Points 1 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA the Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDED:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Regulation of the Financial Matters with the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Concerning the Participation of the Military Units of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Armenia in the International Security Force in Afghanistan signed on 19 October 2009 And 20 October 2009 in the Form of Exchange of Letters are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution, this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
