DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF PART 1, ARTICLE 210 AND PART 2, ARTICLE 216 OF THE CIVIL CODE OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA BASED ON THE APPLICATION OF “DIDI GROUP” LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by Article 100(1), Article 102 of the RA Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 69 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. Part 1, Article 210 of the Civil Code of the Republic of Armenia is in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. To dismiss the case in regard to the determination of the constitutionality of Part 2, Article 216 of the Civil Code of the RA.

3 Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
